

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE CLARK COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE

WHEREAS, the Village of Tremont City is vulnerable to an array of natural hazards that can cause loss of life and damages to public and private property; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Tremont City desires to seek ways to mitigate situations that may aggravate such circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the development and implementation of a hazard mitigation plan can result in actions that reduce the long-term risk to life and property from natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Village of Tremont City Council to protect its citizens and property from the effects of natural hazards by preparing and maintaining a local hazard mitigation plan; and

WHEREAS, it is also the intent of the Village of Tremont City Council to fulfill its obligation under Mitigation Planning, of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to remain eligible to receive state and federal assistance in the event of a declared disaster affecting the Village of Tremont City; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Tremont City, in coordination with [all other participating jurisdictions] has prepared a multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan with input from the appropriate local and state officials;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency and the Federal Emergency Management Agency have reviewed the Clark County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update for legislative compliance and has approved the plan pending the completion of local adoption procedures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of Tremont City Council of the Village of Tremont City hereby:

1. Adopts the Clark County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update; and
2. Agrees to take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the proposed actions of the Plan.
